CLEANING REQUIREMENTS

KITCHEN:

- 1. Clean all cupboards, counters and woodwork.
- 2. Clean kitchen sinks and faucet fixtures.
- 3. Clean stove under burners, knobs, top and oven.
- 4. Wash all marks off the walls.
- 5. Floors should be swept and mopped.
- 6. Light fixtures should be taken down and clean.

<u>UTILITITY ROOMS OR AREAS AND HALLWAYS:</u>

- 1. Clean woodwork (doors, shelves, etc.)
- 2. Wash all wall and baseboards.
- 3. Clean light fixtures.
- 4. Wash floors and stairs, where applicable.

LIVING ROOM:

- 1. Clean the windowsill and windows. Drapery or blinds need to be dusted
- 2. Clean the baseboards and marks off walls.
- 3. Woodwork (closets, shelves, doorframes, etc.) must be washed.
