#### EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Executive Director Martinez reported she participated in meetings with Clallam County Commissioner Peach and Clallam County Commissioner Johnson regarding House Bill 1590. The HB1590 group which Commissioner Robinson and Commissioner Tinker are a part of, has been having regular meetings regarding the tax increase and how funds could be dispersed. Currently there was not a firm commitment on passing this tax increase. It was collectively decided, as a group, to schedule a discussion with Clallam County Commissioner Ozias on Monday November 29, 2021. Commissioner Robinson and Director Martinez had a good follow up discussion with Commissioner Johnson after the groups meeting with him. The group has been invited to attend a work session on Friday December 3, 2021 to present to all three commissioners. PHA is continuing to work through our IT upgrade. Katherine Purcell has been hired as our Executive Assistant and payroll specialist.

Commissioner Robinson: Habitat for Humanity closed on 4.5 acres property on October 29, 2021 within the Sequim City limits. First Federal Community Foundation donated \$100,000 towards the purchase in addition to \$50,000 from Jamestown S'Klallam Tribe. Working on converting newly obtained property from single family to multi-family housing. Waiting on the new members of the City Council to be sworn in before this proposal is presented.
